

French National Scheme for Agricultural Waste Management



Currently, **300,000 French farmers** are sorting and returning their used packaging and plastics waste. A.D.I.VALOR, the voluntary scheme established in France to recover farm plastics waste, **collected 76.000 tons of this material in 2017**.

A.D.I.VALOR currently recycles up to **90% of collected material**. Recycling of agricultural packaging and plastics **reduces CO2 emissions by 60,000 tons per annum**.*

* This is equivalent to the emissions of 25.000 vehicles for 1 year.
